GUIDELINES FOR PERFORMANCES

We have missed seeing YOU in our audiences and visiting with you after our performances. Orpheus is following the guidelines of the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and continually evaluating our procedures, to make sure our concerts will be as safe as possible. One of those measures will be shorter performances of approximately 60 minutes with no intermission. Concert seating will be evaluated at the time of the concerts and will be dependent upon the venue and the number of tickets sold.
